

# N Korea's spy satellite falls into sea

Setback to Kim Jong Un's push to boost military capabilities as spy satellite fails at launch

North Korea's attempt to put the country's first spy satellite into space failed on Wednesday in a setback to leader Kim Jong Un's push to boost his military capabilities as tensions with the United States and South Korea rise.

After an unusually quick admission of failure, North Korea vowed to conduct a second launch after learning what went wrong with its rocket liftoff. It suggests Kim remains determined to expand his weapons arsenal and apply more pressure on Washington and Seoul while diplomacy is stalled.

South Korea and Japan briefly urged residents to take shelter during the launch.

The South Korean military said it was salvaging an object presumed to be part of the crashed North Korean

rocket in waters 200 kilometers (124 miles) west of the southwestern island of Eocheongdo.

Later, the Defense Ministry released photos of a white, metal cylinder it described as a suspected rocket part.

A satellite launch by North Korea is a violation of U.N. Security Council resolutions that ban the country from conducting any launch based on ballistic technology. Observers say North Korea's previous satellite launches helped improve its long-

range missile technology. North Korea long-range missile tests in recent years demonstrated a potential range that could reach all of the continental US, but outside experts say the North Korea still has some work to do to obtain functioning nu-

clear missiles.

The newly developed Cholima-1 rocket was launched at 6:37 am at the North's Sohae Satellite Launching Ground in the northwest, carrying the Malligyong-1 satellite. The rocket crashed off the Korean Peninsula's western coast after it lost thrust following the separation of its first and second stages, the North's official Korean Central News Agency said.

South Korea's military said the North Korean rocket had "an abnormal flight" before it fell in the water. Japan's Chief Cabinet Secretary Hirokazu Matsuno told reporters that no object was believed to have reached space.

North Korea media said the country's space agency will investigate what it calls "the serious defects revealed" by the launch and conduct a second launch as soon as possible.

# Twitter may now be worth one-third what Musk paid for

Twitter may now be worth one-third of what Elon Musk paid for the social media platform just seven months ago.

Financial services company Fidelity has reduced the market value of its equity stake in Twitter for a third time, now putting it at USD 6.55 billion. That's down from the nearly USD 20 billion Fidelity valued its stake at in October. It is unclear how Fidelity came up with its valuation figures, but as a public company, it's required to provide investors with updates on its holdings.

Because Twitter is a private company now called X Holdings Corp., information about its finances can't be verified. Musk took control of Twitter in October, after a protracted legal battle and

months of uncertainty. The CEO of Tesla, who also owns SpaceX, bought Twitter for USD 44 billion.

The billionaire financed the purchase with funds including loans from a group of banks. Musk has said the USD 44 billion price tag for Twitter was too high but that the company had great potential.

By April, Musk was telling the BBC that running Twitter has been "quite painful" but that the social media company is now roughly breaking even after he acquired it late last year. Musk predicted at the time that Twitter could become "cash flow positive" in the current quarter "if current trends continue".

# 9 more members from Imran's party to be tried under Army Act

Nine more members of Imran Khan's Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf party were arrested and handed over to the Pakistan Army on Wednesday to be tried under the stringent Pakistan Army Act over their alleged role in the May 9 attacks on sensitive military installations and government buildings.

With these arrests, the number of PTI activists to be tried under the Army Act and the Official Secrets Act has exceeded 50.

"On the orders of the anti-terrorism courts, nine suspects belonging to PTI and involved in the attack on the ISI buildings (in Faisalabad) and military installations in Multan Cantonment were handed to the Pakistan Army on Wednesday for their trial under the Army Act and Official Secrets Act," a court official said. On May 9, violent protests erupted after paramilitary Rangers arrested 70-year-old Khan.

## Pak court extends Imran's bail plea

The Islamabad High Court on Wednesday extended former Pakistan prime minister Imran Khan's bail in the Al Qadir Trust corruption case for three days and directed him to approach the relevant accountability court. The order was issued by a division bench headed by

Justice Miangul Hassan Aurangzeb. Tight security was put in place at the high court premises. A video shared on Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) party's official Twitter account showed Khan entering the Islamabad High Court (IHC) as his security personnel held up bulletproof shields, the Dawn newspaper reported.

# Chinese jet gets aggressive with US plane

The US military said on Tuesday that a Chinese fighter jet flew aggressively close to a US reconnaissance aircraft over the South China Sea, forcing the American pilot to fly through the turbulent wake.

The Chinese J-16 fighter pilot "flew directly in front of the nose of the RC-135," which was conducting rou-

tine operations in international airspace last Friday, US Indo-Pacific Command said in a statement.

It called the Chinese move an "unnecessarily aggressive maneuver."

US defense leaders have complained that China's military has become significantly more aggressive over the past five years, intercepting US aircraft and ships in the region.

# Sudan military suspends talks with paramilitary rival

Sudan's military has suspended its participation in talks with a paramilitary force it's been battling for weeks for control of the northeastern African country, a military spokesman said on Wednesday.

The development was a blow to the United States and Saudi Arabia, which have been mediating between the two sides whose conflict has plunged Sudan into chaos.

Brig Nabil Abdalla, a spokesman for the Sudanese armed forces, told The Associated Press that the move is a protest to the Rapid Support Forces "repeated violations" of the humanitarian cease-fire, including their

continued occupation of hospitals and other civilian infrastructure in the capital, Khartoum.

Sudan descended into chaos after fighting erupted in mid-April between the

military, led by Gen. Abdel-Fattah Burhan, and the RSF, commanded by Gen. Mohammed Hamdan Dagalo.

The fighting has killed at least 866 civilians and wounded thousands more.

# SpaceX flight returns from space station

A private flight carrying two Saudi astronauts and other passengers returned to Earth late on Tuesday night after a nine-day trip to the International Space Station.

The SpaceX capsule carrying the four parachuted into the Gulf of Mexico, just off the Florida panhandle, 12 hours after undocking from the orbiting lab.

# US announces measures against Kosovo

Pristina: The US has announced measures against Kosovo after more than 90 people, including NATO soldiers, were injured in violent clashes in the country's Serb-majority northern area. American Ambassador in Pristina, Jeffrey Hovenier, said the US "foresaw the consequences" of the decision to forcibly install ethnic Albanian mayors in four majority-Serb municipalities, reports the BBC.
