Gadkari's dream: Indian infra ...

To protect the environment from pollution, roads need to be turned into green roads. In this regard, such trees shall be planted alongside the roads which absorb carbon dioxide. Underlining that no compromise shall be made in quality of construction, he stressed that there was a need to bring down cost of construction. He said that infrastructure is top priority of PM Narendra Modi. He spoke about using white topping instead of bitumen in road construction so that roads do not get damaged during monsoon. He said that India's logistic cost is 14% while China's logistic cost is just 8%. He emphasized the need to bring down logistic costs by going for better transportation network. Vijaya Rahatkar ...

Rahatkar's tenure will begin with immediate effect. The announcement will also be published in the Gazette of India. In addition to the appointment of Rahatkar, Archana Majumdar has been officially named a member of the NCW for a tenure of three years, as per a notification issued by the Ministry of Women and Child Development.

The NCW, a statutory body, is empowered to work towards the advancement of women's rights. Its mandate includes reviewing the constitutional and legal safeguards provided for women. According to a statement issued by the Women and Child Development Ministry, Rahatkar has demonstrated leadership skills across various political and social responsibilities.

During her tenure as the chairperson of the Maharashtra State Commission for Women (2016-2021), she spearheaded initiatives like 'Sakshama' (support for acid attack survivors), 'Prajwala' (linking self-help groups to Central government schemes), and 'Suhita' (a 24x7 helpline service for women).

She also worked on legal reforms focusing on issues like Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO), anti-triple talaq cells, and anti-human trafficking units. Rahatkar also introduced digital literacy programmes

and launched a publication named "Saad" dedicated to women's issues.

He added that the woman who was found dead has been identified as Lalita Dubey (80). Her husband, who is now no more, had been posted as a head constable in the city earlier. As per police, Dubey had three sons, of whom one had died a year ago, while another one resides in Indore. She used to live with her third son, Arun Dubey in Bhopal. The residents of the colony told the police that Arun is mentally unstable. Caesarea, a town located to the north of Tel Aviv, is home to several businessmen and politicians. It also holds several strategic assets including military bases and oil refineries. Following the incident, the Israeli military imposed stringent restrictions on the Israeli media and also sealed off the area. Indian diplomats in Canada...

"There was definitely a threat and that's exactly why the RCMP decided to take the extraordinary measure of making public the fact that Canadians were being intimidated, [were] victims of extortion or even [received] death threats because agents and diplomats from India were linked to these criminal actions," Joly said at a press conference in Montreal. Joly stated that while Russia has targeted Germany and the United Kingdom with this kind of transnational repression, it's never been seen before in Canada at this scale and the government "needed to stand firm on this issue."

"We've never seen that in our history," said Joly. "That level of transnational repression cannot happen on Canadian soil." India, on its part, also expelled six Canadian diplomats hours after it summoned Canada's Charge d'Affaires Stewart Wheeler and conveyed that the "baseless targeting of the Indian High Commissioner and other diplomats and officials in Canada was completely unacceptable."

Ex Indian spy, wanted ...

The police booked Yadav and Abdullah under sections 364A (kidnapping for ransom), 307 (attempt to murder), 328 (causing harm to another person using poison), 506 (criminal intimidation), 323 (voluntarily causing hurt), 341 (wrong restraint), 392 (robbery), 411 (dishonestly receiving stolen property) and 120B (criminal conspiracy) of the Indian Penal Code (IPC).

The police filed a charge sheet naming Yadav on March 13 this year before he was granted interim bail for six days on March 22 on grounds of "illness" of his one-year-old daughter. On April 22, the court granted regular bail to Yadav.

INDIA bloc announces Jharkhand seat deal

Jharkhand Chief Minister Hemant Soren on Saturday said that the INDIA bloc partners will contest the upcoming assembly polls together and the Congress and the JMM will field candidates in 70 of 81 seats.

Seat-sharing talks are on with alliance partners - the RJD and the Left parties - for the remaining 11 seats, he said.

The assembly polls for 81 seats will be held in two phases on November 13 and 20, and counting will take place on November 23.

"INDIA bloc will contest the Jharkhand assembly polls together. It has been decided during the seat-sharing talks with the allies that the Congress and the JMM will field candidates in 70 of 81 seats," Soren said after meeting with

Singh, a 1989-batch Indian Police Service (IPS) officer of the Jharkhand cadre, officially assumed office following a state government notification issued on Saturday evening.

BJP's FIRST LIST IS OUT

The BJP on Saturday released its first list of 66 candidates for the Jharkhand assembly elections, fielding party president Babul Marandi from Dhanwar and former chief minister Champai Soren from Saraikeela. The party named Sita Soren, the sister-in-law of JMM leader and Chief Minister Hemant Soren, as its nominee from Jamtara. The list also has the names of Geeta Koda and former Union minister Sudarshan Bhagat.

Soren said the JMM-led alliance was confident of retaining power in the state on the back of its development work. The NDA on Friday announced its seat-sharing formula among its partners. The BJP will contest 68 seats, AJSU Party 10, JD(U) 2 and LJP (Ram Vilas) 1.



He accused BJP of calling tribals as 'vanvasis', alleging it was trying to destroy their history. "When BJP people call the tribals as vanvasis, they destroy your way of living, history and science, you have been following for thousands of years. Advasi means the first owners while vanvasi means those who live in the forest."

U'khand: '1 lakh fine to prevent spitting on food

The Uttarakhand government issued guidelines to prevent people from spitting in food items and announced a fine of up to ₹1 lakh for the offence.

According to the CMO, a comprehensive standard operating procedure has been issued in this regard following the directions of the chief minister. "On spitting and mixing dirt in food items in Uttarakhand CM Pushkar Singh Dhama has made it clear that such incidents will not be tolerated at all in the state," CMO said on X. "Strict action will be taken against those found spitting or mixing other filth in food items, with a provision of imposing a fine ranging from ₹25,000 to ₹1 lakh," it added. Earlier this week, Dhama assured action against "land jihad, love jihad, and thook (spit) jihad". "The original form of Devbhoomi Uttarakhand should remain intact," he said.

ED asks officers to question people only during office

NEW DELHI. The Enforcement Directorate has issued a fresh circular directing its officials or investigating officers (IOs) not to question people called on summons at "unearthly" hours and not keep them waiting for hours at their office.

The technical circular was issued on October 11 after the Bombay High Court directed the federal agency to issue directives in this context as it took up the petition of a person who was summoned by the ED and "detained overnight and interrogated."

The HC found that the 64-year-old petitioner was summoned to the ED office for questioning and was kept waiting post mid-night. Recording of his statement, at unearthly hours, "definitely results in deprivation of a person's sleep, basic human right of an individual", it said.
