

NATURE'S WRATH | 454 roads closed amid heavy rain Cloudburst triggers flash floods in Rampur, HP

Intermittent rain lashed parts of Himachal Pradesh on Thursday, while Rampur in Shimla witnessed a cloudburst that triggered flash floods in the area.

Landslides in several parts of the state resulted in the closure of 454 roads, including two national highways.

The cloudburst at Darshal occurred late Wednesday night, causing flash floods in the Teklech market. No casualties were reported, as nearby houses had already been evacuated due to the threat of flooding, officials noted.

In Shimla, a tree fell on the office building of the science and technology department at the US Club, damaging part of the roof along with a vehicle.

The electricity supply was disrupted in several areas of the city due to downed power lines and uprooted trees. Restoration teams were deployed to restore

As a result of the flooding and landslides, a total of 454 roads were closed to vehicular traffic, including the Old Hindustan-Tibet Road (NH 5) and the Aut-Sainj road (NH

305). The Chandigarh-Manali National Highway (NH 21) reopened after nearly 40 hours on Thursday afternoon.

Among the closed roads, 245 were in Mandi, while 118 were in the neighbouring Kullu district, according to the

State Emergency Operation Centre (SEOC).

Meanwhile, the 14th Battalion of the National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) engaged in recovering the body of a devotee who slipped from a cliff near Ganesh Gufa on the Kinnaur Kailash route on Wednesday.

UTTARKASHI CALAMITY

OVER 274 RESCUED AS OPERATIONS GATHER PACE

More than 60 still missing

Rescue operations gathered pace on Thursday in the disaster-hit Dharali village in Uttarkashi as weather improved and more than 270 people stranded in different locations in the district were evacuated to safety with the help of IAF's Chinook and Mi-17 helicopters.

The army said 50 civilians are missing besides nine of its personnel including one junior commissioned officer. However, eyewitnesses said the number of missing persons could be even higher.

According to officials, at least four people have been killed in the disaster that struck the ecologically fragile area on Tuesday afternoon. Rescuers recovered two bodies on Wednesday, but it was not clear if these were among the four deaths reported the previous day.

With a let-up in rain and improvement in weather conditions, helicopters made several sorties during the day to evacuate people who had taken refuge in army camps and neighbouring villages after the disaster.

A team of 69 NDRF rescuers, two cadaver dogs and veterinarians joined rescue operations to look for survivors.

"This is a big disaster and the analysis of the damage is going on. The roads connecting Uttarkashi have

been badly damaged. However, our teams are working in the affected areas to rescue the victims," NDRF DIG Gambhir Singh Chauhan told PTI.

A total of 274 people have been brought to Haridwar, Disaster Management Secretary Vinod Kumar Suman said.

Uttarkashi District Magistrate Prashant Arya said 275 people from Haridwar, Gangotri and Jhala have been sent to Matli helipad from where they are being sent to their respective destinations.

Bengal: Houses of women BJP workers vandalised in Cooch Behar

Houses of three women BJP workers have been vandalised in the Dinhatra area of Cooch Behar district in West Bengal, a day after the state Leader of the Opposition Suwendu Adhikari's convoy was attacked in the same district, in which seven Trinamool Congress workers were arrested.

On Thursday, the houses of BJP workers Juthika Barman, Maina Barman, and Purabi Barman were attacked, and they were chased away from their houses. The BJP alleged that Trinamool workers and miscreants were behind the attack.

BJP's Cooch Behar organisational district president, Abhijit Barman, told media persons that the fresh attack was carried out in retaliation for the arrest of Trinamool Congress workers on Wednesday, accused of attacking the convoy of the Leader of the Opposition earlier this week.

Can't sleep: J&K locals call for relocation amid anti-terror op

Amidst the ongoing anti-terror operation in Kulgam, which entered its seventh day on Thursday, locals from the Akhal village have called for their relocation from the area, citing severe hardships.

The residents claimed they were unable to sleep due to the relentless firing and were now running out of food as well. "We have been facing severe difficulties for the past seven days. Firing and bombs go on during the night. There is a shortage of ration in our

homes now," Mubarak Khanday, a villager living close to the encounter site, said.

Emphasising that the women and children in the area are terrified, Khanday claimed that they have developed 'psychological problems' due to the continuous firing and explosions, he added.

Appealing to the government to make arrangements for their relocation, Khanday said, "We have not slept for seven days. Children are awake, and they cry. There is a shortage of medicine and rations."

HC: Didn't order closure of 'Kabutarshanas'... But people's health is important'

The Bombay High Court on Thursday said it had not passed any order directing the closure of 'Kabutarshanas' (pigeon-feeding spots) in the city, but only refrained from staying the closure order of the municipal corporation.

A committee of experts can study whether the old Kabutarshanas in the city should continue, but "human life is of paramount importance", it said.

"If something affects the larger health of senior citizens and kids, then it should be looked into. There has to be a balance," the court said.

Earlier this week, sheets were placed covering the Kabutarshanas in the city, leading to protests. Maharashtra Chief Minister Devendra Fadnis had then claimed that the Kabutarshanas were closed following the high court's order.

A bench of Justices G S Kulkar and Arif Doctor on Thursday clarified that it had not passed any order.

"It was the BMC's (Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation) decision (to close Kabutarshanas) which was challenged before us. We did not pass any order. We only did not grant any interim relief," the HC said.
